EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR COMMENTS....

On June 1, 2020 we will be starting to relax some of the restrictions we put in place to protect the staff and residents. The reopening of facilities and transportation will be done in accordance with the State of Delaware requirements and CDC recommendations. Each activity will be evaluated and we will establish recommended protocols to insure safety. Transportation will begin with reduced capacity and requirements for wearing masks and cleaning the vehicles regularly. Most of you are aware that 65% of the deaths in Delaware are associated with nursing homes and senior facilities. Successful reopening will be dependent upon cooperation of all residents and their guests. We have done well and also been lucky that no resident or staff member has contracted the Covid19 virus to date. Please exercise caution in all you do and we will get through this pandemic together.

I realize that wearing a face covering/mask is a nuisance, however it is still probably the most effective way to prevent the spread of the virus. The mask needs to cover both your mouth and nose to be effective. Additionally hand washing is extremely important to prevent the transmission from surfaces. We are increasing the cleaning of hand rails, doors and elevators since they are surfaces that many touch every day. Masks will be required inside all facilities with only a few exceptions and will be used on transportation so be prepared. Masks do not need to be worn outside away from the entrances as long a social distancing is followed (6 feet).


Everyone needs to understand that restrictions and directives from the state can change so we will update any changes as soon as we can. Please be flexible.




In June Kent County will be installing a new sewer line that unfortunately traverses the entire Luther Towers Campus. The line will cause the closure of Lakeview Drive and will affect the traffic flow when leaving. The construction will start near the south end




of Luther Towers III and proceed north to the exit columns and then on the west side of Luther Towers I.



From the west side the line will run through the back garden area between the large Magnolia tree and the Cherry tree, then between the gazebo and Luther Towers I north entrance.



The line then travels up through the center of the Luther Towers II parking area to the north and to the fence. All parking will be closed in front of Luther Towers II during construction so residents will be directed to the other parking areas near Luther Towers IV south lot and the visitor lot near the entrance. Hopefully this construction will be completed in about a week so we will reestablish parking as soon as possible after construction is completed. We are still holding coordination meetings and I will share the information as I get it. Watch for postings on Telagenda.



We have a new maintenance technician Mr. Lew Friday who joined the staff on May 18, 2020. He will be learning the job so you will be seeing him around campus. He will be hard to miss as he is taller than Kelly. Make sure you take to opportunity to say hi when you see him.

"You may not control all the events that happen to you but you can decide not to be reduced by them." - Maya Angelou


Governor Carney's guidance states that the best defense against COVID-19 is frequent hand washing, avoiding being around sick people, staying home/physical distancing, and avoiding touching your face, mouth, eyes, and nose with unwashed hands.
