We have had snow, wind, rain and the occasional warm and sunny day over the last month. Can't wait for Spring – it is my favorite time of year. Another thing that happens this month – the clocks go back! Hooray for the extra hour!

#### Here is some important information of which you need to be aware:

There has been an increase in prescriptions for medical marijuana and other CBD products available. For that reason, I need to make sure you have information that is vital to you as a resident in Luther Towers / Luther Village. Delaware (state) has allowed the use of medical marijuana products for individuals. However, the Federal government has not followed suit. What does this mean for you?



CAMPUSES Rent will be pulled on March 4th.

In some months, your rent may not come out of your account on the 4th **due to holidays or weekends.** 

Please check with your bank to verify rent funds have been deducted *before* pulling your money out while assuming the rent was already paid.

This will save you from Insufficient Funds problems.

Even if it is prescribed by a physician. This also means purchase of such products can not be used as medical expenses, because, according to HUD, they are <u>not legal</u>.

Use of marijuana, in any form, is prohibited on federally funded property. The Controlled Substances Act (CSA) categorizes marijuana as a Schedule 1 substance and, therefore, the manufacture, distribution of, possession of marijuana is a federal criminal offense. Because the CSA prohibits all forms of marijuana use, the use of "medical marijuana" is illegal under federal law even if it is permitted under our state law.

With that said, individuals who are found to be using these types of items may be subject to lease termination.

We have had an increasing number of residents who have been scammed by individuals.



These residents have lost all their money. The scammers will portray they are in a relationship with you and convince you that eventually they will unite with you.

Some things they might ask you to do are: sending gift cards and asking for your account information. One of the most popular scams is Bitcoin. Bitcoin-Mining scams will promise to give you 50% return on your investment every month. During the first month of this scam, you send the scammer money, then they send you your money back plus a little bit extra. Because you got a return on your money, the next month you're likely to invest more.

The scammer will keep sending you your money back until you invest a large amount. Then they take it all and run.

Bitcoin scams can be devastating. Because cryptocurrency is not backed by the government, if you have been a victim of a scam, there are no customer service representatives to call. If anyone is asking you to send money or they want to send you money, you should be very cautious because more than likely it's a scam.


#### **Kelly's Reminders:**
