I am the Coordinator of a lay, Christian, caring ministry called Stephen Ministry. This worldwide ministry has been in service since 1975 when a Lutheran Pastor, who was also a trained Clinical Psychologist, began the ministry with his wife. In Dover, since 2006, we have helped 86 cases in our church and community and want to help you as well. We are a team of 12 lay people who have been equipped with 50 hours of initial training in care giving skills such as active listening, confidentiality, and many other skills as well.

These skills primarily focus on how to help grieving people who experience a loss of a loved one, their health, or finances. We also target helping people to cope with any change in their life, even loneliness. There are brochures in each building if you want to find out more information. Men meet with men and women meet with women.




Kelly's Reminders:




