**From the Desk of The Executive Director**

You won’t want to miss it; food and fellowship are always enjoyable. This is also one of the opportunities we get to show you how much we appreciate you!

Another thing we enjoy doing is making your facilities more enjoyable. As most are aware, we have done improvements/renovations in many areas in an attempt to bring them more up-to-date. Not to mention more appealing to the eye! You can thank Jessica Parsons for décor choices – that is all her.

The most recent renovation completed was the Laundry room in Luther Towers III. (*see pictures next page*) The renovation allowed for them to have more space, seating and an extra dryer. Our staff works hard to make sure all public areas are clean and this is a constant battle. We ask that you please do your part and help us keep it looking clean. ***Now onto the part of my job that I don’t like.*** One of the many things I am responsible for is seeing that the terms of the Lease & House Rules are adhered to by all tenants. When there is a violation of one of these rules, I must write notices for lease violations up to the unpleasant task of termination of leases. As I stated earlier,

**I DO NOT ENJOY DOING THIS.**

However, it is a part of my job that I am responsible for accomplishing.

Why are rules important, you may ask?

***Rules are important because families and citizens have to live their lives in a happy but safe state. Some aspects of why rules are important are: to maintain civil behavior; to be organized; to have more harmony in the community.***

I am choosing to highlight one rule violation that my staff and I regularly have to deal with, ***Smoking in the buildings.*** Typically, it is the Security desk that receives a call stating someone smells smoke in their building.

Smoke in general is a safety concern that needs to be investigated immediately. If it is determined smoke is originating from an apartment, they will follow the emergency procedures outlined in the House Rules. There have been instances when there have been actual fires that are active, or recently put out. Most of the time it is just the strong presence of cigarette smoke – which would be a violation of your lease.

Why do we take this so seriously? First of all, smoke emanating from an apartment can indicate a fire, which could result in loss of life. Secondly, years back Mr. Coy made the decision to enforce HUD's transition to no smoking in facilities. There were many reasons for this, but mainly the health and safety of all individuals in the buildings.

At the time, they were also considering making Luther Towers/Luther Village a smoke free

campus, meaning smoking would not be allowed anywhere on the campus. The decision was made not to do that, but establish smoking areas outside (50ft away from buildings) to allow smokers somewhere to go and smoke. Although sometimes inconvenient, at least it is an option.

***We will continue to ensure that

### Learn the Facts about COPD

Early detection of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) is key to successful treatment. If you have any of the symptoms or exposures to risk factors mentioned in the sections below, talk to your doctor about them.

#### Symptoms

- Chronic cough
- Shortness of breath while doing everyday activities (dyspnea)
- Frequent respiratory infections
- Blueness of the lips or fingernail beds (cyanosis)
- Fatigue
- Producing a lot of mucus (also called phlegm or sputum)
- Wheezing

#### Risk Factors

- Smoking
- Breathing secondhand smoke
- Exposure to air pollution
- Working with chemicals, dust and fumes
- A genetic condition called CarePro-1 deficiency
- A history of childhood respiratory infection



Remember: Don't wait for symptoms to become severe because valuable treatment time could be lost. Early detection of COPD is key to successful treatment.

The purpose of the front desk security agent is to provide security, safety and welfare of the residents and staff located at Luther Towers and Luther Village.

◇ That said, one problem we often see is residents opening the door for visitors or allowing them to follow you inside after you have opened the door.

If someone is trying to enter a building, please do not intervene and give them access. They are required to use the Rise system.

We are not asking you to confront visitors if they do follow behind you but just be aware and if they do look suspicious, please report immediately to the front desk.

We rely on residents to adhere to these rules in order to maintain the safety of the residents.

◇ We have received some complaints on people using the trash chutes after “quiet” hours.

**Please do NOT use the trash chutes  
between the hours of 8:00pm-8:00am.**

Please be courteous to those who live near the trash chutes. The noise causes disruption to sleep or if someone is not feeling well. Your lease states that ***“you shall not make or permit noises or acts that will disturb the rights or comfort of neighbors.”***

Recently, we have had either a resident and/or visitor leaving opened bread in the lobby areas. Food that is not packaged is not permitted in the common areas or lobbies. Opened items can lead to unwanted pests and rodents. Items that are packaged may be left for the day – then will be discarded by staff at the end of the day.

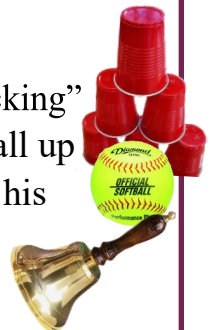


**Employee of the Month**

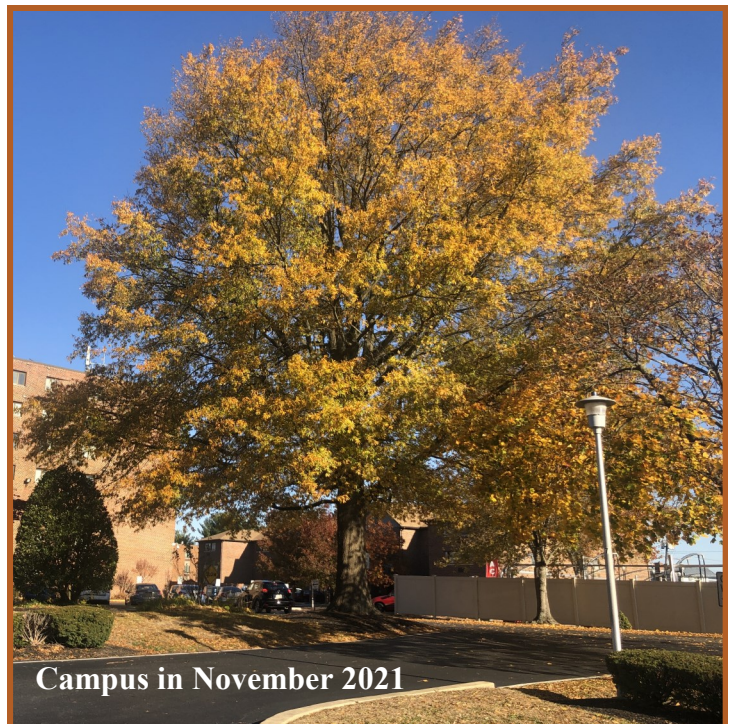

There’s a flower at my window in full bloom.

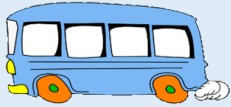
It is radiant in the sunshine, and so cheerful after rain;

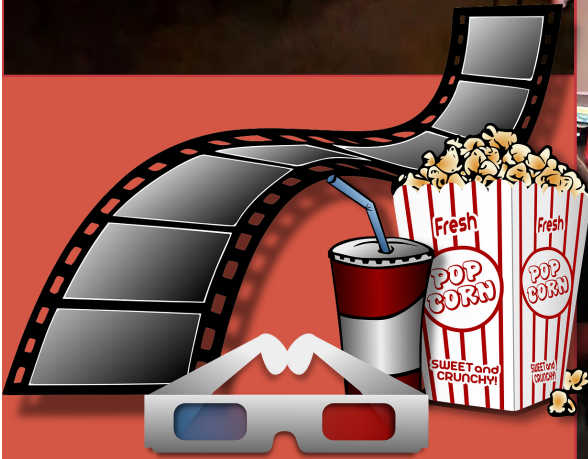

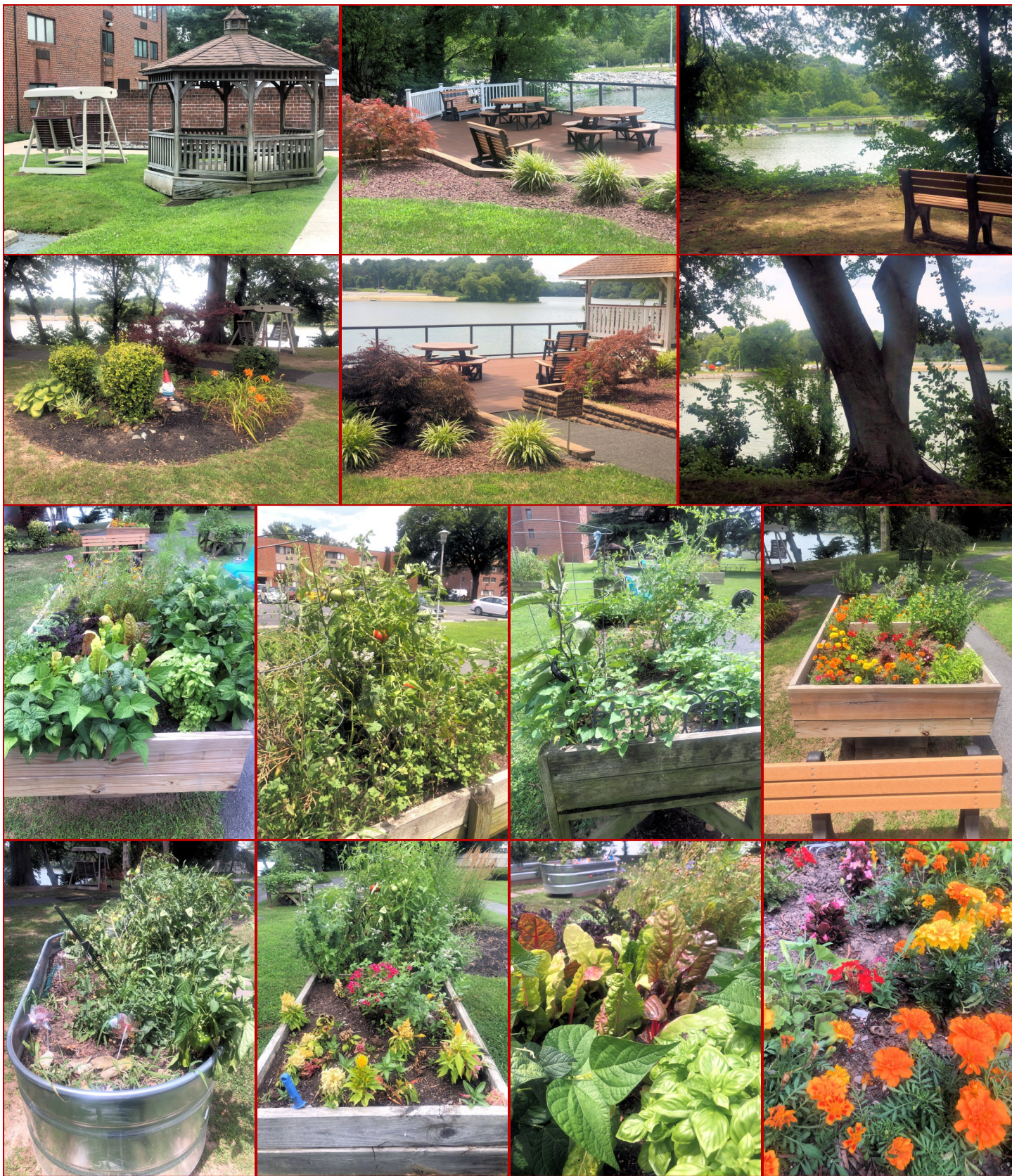
