Last month within the first 8 days we had two individuals walk onto the property at Luther Towers and attempt to access residents' vehicles. The first instance was approximately 4:00 pm in the afternoon. A male individual first went to the Towers 3 parking lot and opened the door to two vehicles and got inside them. He then walked over to Towers 4 parking lot and started pulling on vehicle door handles.

At this point, residents alerted the desk to the incident. Maintenance personnel approached him after he was entering another vehicle and he took off and jumped the fence. We did notify the police, but, by the time they arrived, he was gone.

On January 8th, at approximately 8:00 pm, an individual entered the Luther Towers III parking lot in a car. He broke the back window and entered the vehicle. He got into the driver's seat and was attempting to hotwire the car to steal it. The individual kept leaving the car and going to the vehicle in which he had come onto the property. Security personnel notified the police of the incident. When the individual saw the police approaching, he hopped into the "get away" car and they left the property before the police were able to locate them.

As I have stated in the past, Security is doing a great job monitoring cameras and reporting incidents to the police.

**We ask that you assist by contacting Security if you see something, so we can notify police immediately.**

Also, ensure that you lock your vehicles when you leave them. I have contacted Dover Police and asked them if they could increase the drive throughs on both of our properties. They stated they would attempt to do that. This can be limited based on their manpower at the time. So please pay attention to what may be going on around you and, **remember, if you see something... say something!**

**INSPECTIONS/HALL DÉCOR:**

The Quarterly Health and Safety Inspections will be completed in the month of February. As a reminder, we will give you notice ahead of time and you do not have to be home for the inspection.

If you have items/décor hanging on the walls outside of your apartment door, please remove them. You are allowed to hang a decorative item on your door – but not on the walls.

Please refrain from using scotch tape to tape things to your door. Over time, the tape is hard to remove and/or is not aesthetically pleasing to the eye.

If you have any personal decorative items right outside of your door (tables/décor), they also need to be removed.

**LUTHER VILLAGE III – CAGES:**

We have posted signs by the Luther Village III cage areas to limit access between the hours of 8pm-8am. As a reminder, please do not store anything on the floor in the cage rooms. The rights and comfort of the tenants is important to us. I have included an excerpt from the House Rules below:

**DISTURBANCES:** Residents shall not cause, or permit to be caused, disturbances that interfere with the rights, comfort, or convenience of other residents. Residents and guests are not permitted to interfere with the staff in performance of their duties. Disturbances should be reported immediately to the security desk for documentation and investigation.

**LUTHER VILLAGE I – RECYCLABLES:**

We recently became aware of recyclables being placed in an unauthorized area in the trash room of Luther Village I, 2nd floor. The recyclables were placed through a small door similar to the trash chute but there is no way for us to access all the trash except to cut a hole in the wall or spend a lot of time using a tool to pick up each piece of garbage.

I have no idea how long these recyclables have been in this area but it was shocking to say the least. The trash was almost 5 feet tall from the floor to the top.

Recyclables are to be taken out to the appropriate dumpster; they are not to be placed in the trash room.

**If you are ever uncertain about a policy, please don't hesitate to ask.**



**PACKAGES:**

The package delivery saga continues. We continually get packages that aren’t delivered and are being left in the lobbies. Security is documenting the misdelivered packages and reporting these occurrences to Amazon. If you see a package in the lobby’s front desk areas, please report to the security desk.

**SECURITY:**

As I am typing this, the LT/LV security schedule for February is complete and all shifts are covered. There are times when Luther Village security isn't physically at the desk, but rest assured that the security agent at Luther Towers can monitor the Luther Village cameras.

Kari does her best to keep Luther Village manned 24/7; however, there are times when someone calls out and attempts are made for a replacement, but it's not always possible. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

**VAPING:**

There was a vaping pen with marijuana found in the Luther Village II parlor recently. We have had complaints reporting the smell of marijuana in the same building.



I want to remind residents that, since we are federally subsidized, smoking and/or vaping marijuana is not allowed. You are responsible for your guests.

If it is determined you **OR** a guest is smoking in the building or on the campus...

**You could be subject to immediate termination of your lease.**

**INFORMATION BOTH CAMPUSES**

**RENT will be pulled on February 4th.**

In some months, your rent may not come out of your account on the 4th **due to holidays or weekends.**

Please check with your bank to verify rent funds have been deducted *before* pulling your money out while assuming the rent was already paid.

This will avoid Insufficient Funds problems.

It's that time of year again when the Division of Medicaid and Medical Assistance release new income limits for certain programs.

Please read carefully as many of you are already enrolled in these programs. If you are enrolled, there is no need to call me.

If you are not enrolled and now meet the income guideline, please give me a call.

Please be patient for me to return all phone calls, I may be out at an activity and will return all messages as soon as possible.

**“Income Limit”** means your income must be below that amount to qualify for the program. The income limits are your GROSS income – the amount BEFORE deductions.

### PROGRAMS:

**Full Medicaid** – \$1,255/month or below

**SLMB1 or Q1** (the state pays your Medicare premium): \$1,694.00/month or below.

**Extra Help** with Prescription costs: \$1,883/month or below (significant increase). Asset limit of \$17,220 (cannot have more money than that in the bank)

**DE Prescription Assistance Program:** \$2,510/month or below. No asset limit.

### ACTIVITIES

The calendars for Luther Towers / Village are always in the back of the Newsletter. On these calendars are dates, times and locations for all the events provided to our residents. There is very little down time for anyone to become bored with so much to do while living in the Towers or Village!

Transportation is provided on a regular schedule to certain activities. The Bluebird calendar for these excursions is also in the back with the Activity calendars.



# Valentine's Day

Happy February!

Love is in the air, even if it's not romantic love. One of the most important parts of working at the security desk is making sure that residents feel heard and valued. This is an expression of brotherly love, compassion, and empathy.

It is our duty to address your concerns. It's in our job description, but, I have to say, the individuals on our crew show this caring naturally in one way or another.

One of the things I've noticed recently is when reporting concerns, some residents have gotten their feathers ruffled by questions security asks. Perhaps, the perception is that we don't believe the reports and are questioning the validity of the details.

On the contrary! Security is trained to document facts accurately and ask questions to help them pinpoint the incident with video, time & place, and names of people involved. This is so that the documentation can be done correctly and efficiently.

It takes a lot of time to wade through video footage, so when a resident says, "sometime last week," that is 168 hours of footage.

Sometimes one specific camera doesn't show a good view, so we may have to view 2 or 3 cameras to see the full incident from all perspectives.

Security will ask "around what time it happened." Even if a resident can specify "after dinner" or "in the morning," that helps tremendously. So, please don't feel affronted when security asks for more information.

It's short and sweet, but this scripture verse packs a punch: "Do everything in love."

—1 Corinthians 16:14

So, please report concerns in love, and expect the exact same treatment back from security. I, for one, love my job, the staff I work with, and the residents who make this all possible.

## Quick Reminder:

Incidents, especially noise complaints and smoking inside or within 50 feet of the building should be reported **immediately**. Then security can investigate and document.

Remember, we can't see noise on the videos, but we can document what we hear and address the problem when it's happening. 🙌

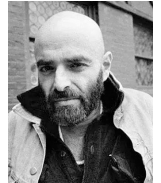

That's an altercation.

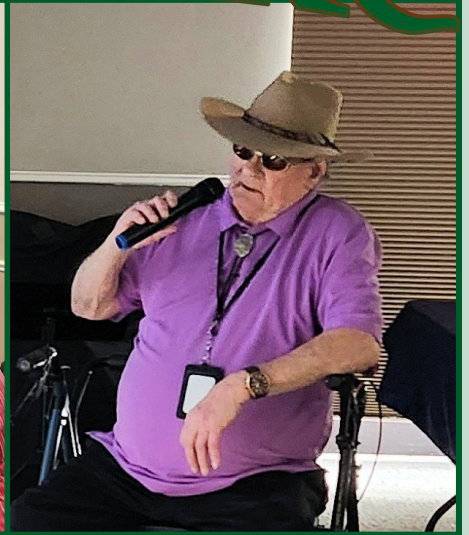
If later we apologize,

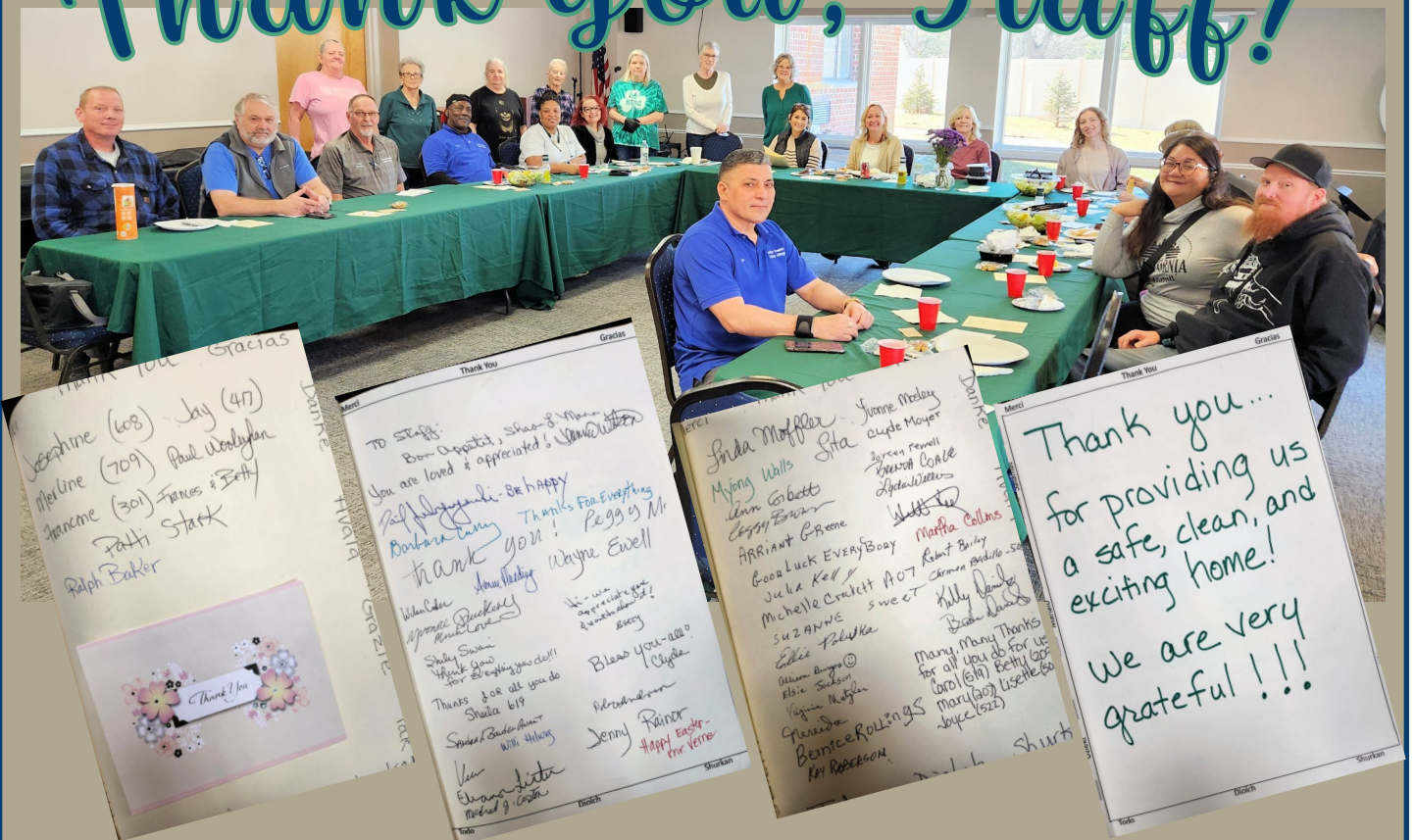
