INFORMATION —BOTH CAMPUSES— RENT Pulled On April 4th

Please check with your bank to verify rent funds have been deducted *before* pulling your money out while assuming the rent was already paid. This will avoid Insufficient Funds problems.

April is here, a month I hold dear, for I turn 63 but is not what I fear; it's looking at you in my lil bus mirror


- Lighter bags is all I ask for because heavy ones make my back sore, and not the "soar" like to new heights, but like the one for starting some fights.






