Allowing all good things to last.

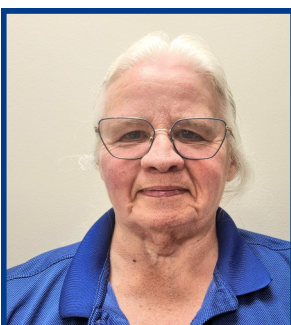
A book to read, a cloud to trace,

Gentle Reminders:

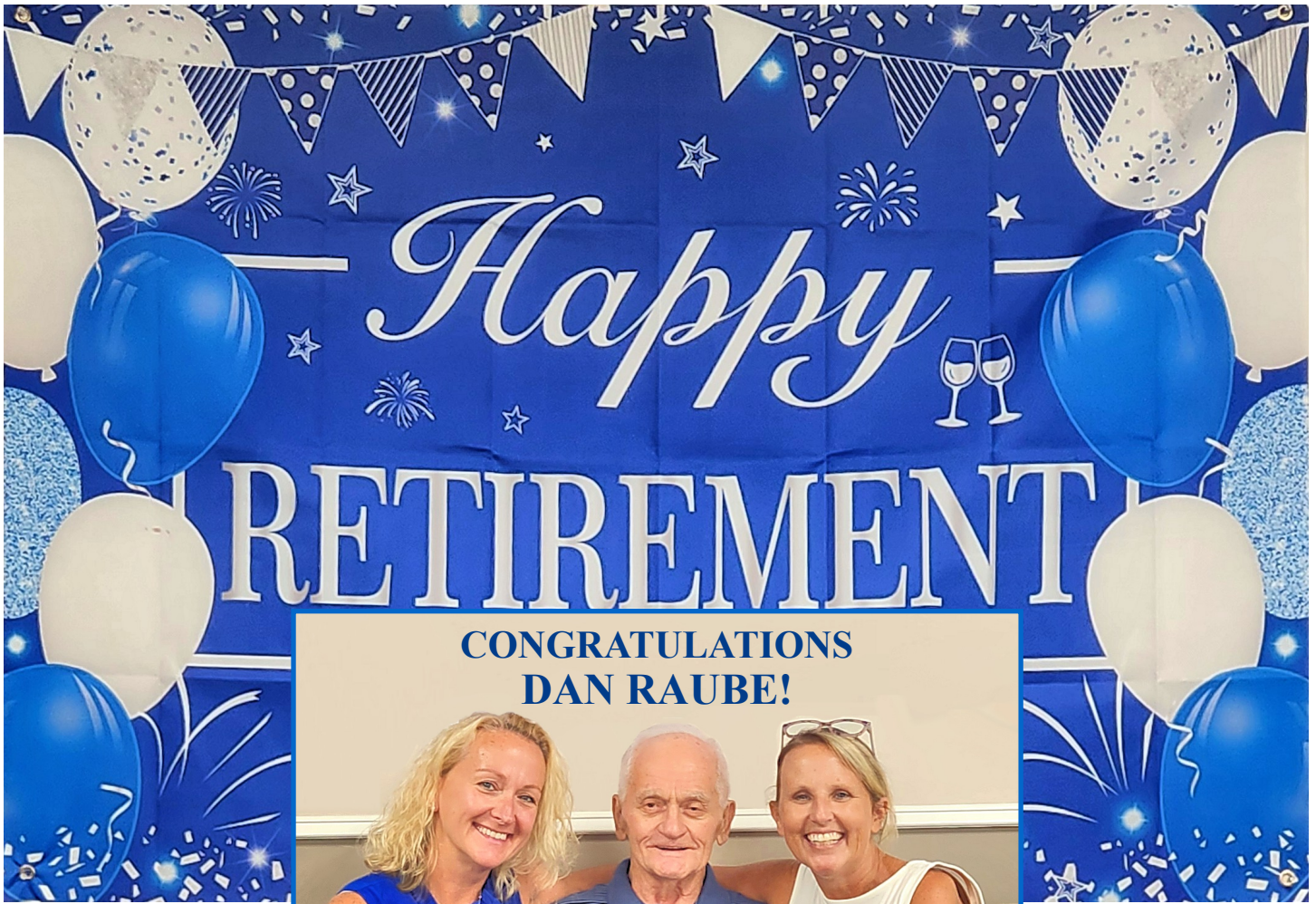

Note from Tricia:

Nemours Senior Care Health Clinic

Discounted services for Dental, Vision, and Hearing. Must meet eligibility requirements:

- Age 65 or older
- Delaware Resident
- Annual Income must be below these amounts:

Individual: \$2,196/month

Married Couple: \$3,406/month

If you are interested in services, you will need to call Nemours Senior Care in Milford at: **302-424-5420**.

Participants must make an appointment to meet in person to check eligibility require-

ments. After your eligibility appointment, they will make an appointment for you to return to be seen.

Participants have access to very reasonable eye exams, eyeglasses, dentures, cleanings, hearing tests. It is a great program.

While transportation to Milford can be difficult to obtain, **Faith in Action** provides free transportation to Milford Nemours Senior Care through its nonprofit services. Please reach out to Tricia to get information on Nemours transportation.

Hello, Everyone!

Greetings, good people of Luther Towers and Luther Village!

Your friendly, neighborhood Resident Support Coordinator is here to share a few friendly reminders about our wonderful transportation options: the BLUEBIRD Bus and the Medical Transportation Van.

BLUEBIRD Friendly Reminders

- ♦ Reservations must be made 24 hours prior to your desired trip.
- ♦ An aide may accompany you on a trip... but please remember that our residents take priority for all seats. If the trip you are signing up for becomes full, your aide's seat will be given to a resident.
- ♦ Special Trips are scheduled on the last Thursday of each month. The special trip destination is shared with all residents, via the TelAgenda monitors in each building. *You may not sign up for the special trip until it has been announced to all residents.*
- ♦ Feel free to direct any questions or concerns with me.

Medical Transportation Reminders

- ♦ Reservations are required for Medical Transportation. Contact the security desk to schedule your appointment at least 24 hours in advance.
- ♦ Please do not call the Medical Transportation cell phone to check for same day ride availability or to schedule appointments.
- ♦ The Medical Transportation driver should only be called when you are ready to be picked up from your appointment.

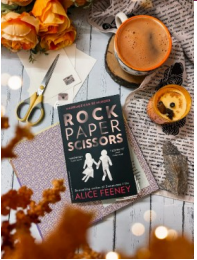

ROCK PAPER SCISSORS

A Review by Jack Ostram



To say Alice Feeney's novel **Rock Paper Scissors** has a few twists would be an understatement. To say it takes some focus is a reality. Ms. Feeney weaves a convoluted, intricate tale that will please some readers and frustrate others.

Rock Paper Scissors is a novel about a couple, Adam and Amelia Wright, and an effort to resurrect what seems to be a failing marriage. The story opens as the Wright's are on the road heading to a converted chapel with the hope of saving the relationship.

Adam, a screenwriter, suffers from prosopagnosia which is an inability to recognize faces – even family. “Imagine not being able to recognize your wife, or your best friend, or the person responsible for killing your mother right in front of you as a kid,” he says. He's frustrated not only with his condition but with his marriage and career.

Amelia, on the surface, seems to be a concerned wife wanting to save what seems to be left of their marriage. Unfortunately, both harbor a few secrets. She inexplicably won a weekend at this old chapel, supposedly haunted and rundown.

The chapel holds its own secrets and is looked over by an older gray-haired woman. Robin, the caretaker, lives in a cottage down the road and is as creepy as the chapel. With good reason but I won't tell you. Why spoil the fun?

Arriving in a driving snowstorm, the Wrights have no way into this mysterious chapel. After exploring the lower interior, imagine their surprise to find the bedroom an exact duplicate of their own.

Interspersed are letters to Adam from his wife on their anniversary. What is interesting about these letters is they offer the reader clues about the relationship and her true feelings toward Adam and his chosen career. Sometimes you get more out of what is edited than what the writer really means. For example, daydreaming (crossed out) vs staring, always think you know best (crossed out) vs wouldn't listen. There are others – hidden gems if you pay attention.

It is interesting to watch Amelia and Adam try to figure out their situation. Once one seems to be resolved, another pops up with its own peculiar twist. The Wrights want to get back to London but, at the moment, are trapped there when they discover their tires are slashed and there is no hope nearby.

Rock Paper Scissors is entertaining and somewhat a quick read, but I would suggest you read it carefully. Savor it. Enjoy the twists. They come unexpectedly and sometimes immediately followed by another.

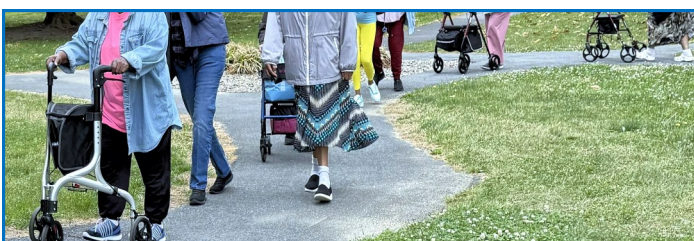
